'Science and Religion: the Urgent Need for a Synthesis'

Today we can see increasing trends in the world towards globalization. We are witnessing economic activities crossing national boundaries, emergence of global fashion and trends, advancement of 'universal' values and formation of 'the world without borders'. Huge numbers of migrants are moving from place to place looking for jobs and better lives. In Memory of Saint Priest Martyr Archimandrite Grigol Peradze

Archimandrite Grigol Peradze was a Georgian ecclesiastic figure, theologian and historian.

He graduated from the University of Bonn with a doctoral degree in Philosophy, awarded for his dissertation *History of the Georgian Monasticism from its creation until 1064*. He carried out extensive research in Germany, France and England and studied old patristic manuscripts in the library collections of the British Museum and Oxford University.

In 1931 Grigol Peradze took religious vows and was ordained. In 1933 he began teaching at the Faculty of Orthodox Theology of Warsaw University. In 1934 Father Grigol received the dignity of Archimandrite.

After the outbreak of war he continued his work in Polish Orthodox Metropolis. In May 1942 he was arrested by the Gestapo and sent to Auschwitz.

All his life archimandrite Grigol remained true to his Christian commitment - helping people in need. Confirmed by the testimony of witnesses, Father Grigol's martyrdom gave the highest confirmation to what he once said: *'Through the cross and thorns leads the path to victory'*.

Grigol Peradze was canonized by the Georgian Orthodox and Apostolic Church in 1995. Archimandrite Grigol left behind a rich legacy of over 70 theological and scientific works published in Georgian, French, English, German and Polish.

FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS TO BE PUBLISHED IN CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

V International conference
Orthodox Christian Scholar in the Modern World

Papers can be presented in **English, German, Polish, and Russian**. However, if you send a non-English paper, **abstracts, key words, title of the paper, and names of authors must be submitted in English** to be registered with Russian Science Citation Index system.

Formatting specific areas of your paper (in the following order):

The title of your document should be **bold**, centered (+ English version)

The author(s) information (full name(s), e-mail address) *italicized*, centered (+ English version)

The supervisor information (for recent graduates) (Name, e-mail address) *italicized*, centered (+ English version)

The full name of organization, city, country *italicized*, centered (+ English version)

The paper text and images meeting the requirements

- **References** must be numbered in the order cited in the manuscript and indicated in the text by a number in square brackets (e.g. [1], [2, 5]). Your reference list should appear at the end of your paper.
- **Tables and figures** should be numbered. In-text references should be provided for any images.

General layout of your paper:

- Your paper should be no more than 850 words **in length**
- **Margins** must be 2 cm for the left, right, bottom and top of the page
- **Font** must be Times New Roman throughout the document, Main Body of the Text - 11pt, Figure and Table Captions - 9pt. (If you want to use a font other than Times New Roman, do attach the font file in your e-mail)
- **Paragraph indentation** should be 1 cm
- Use **single-spacing** between lines
- **Paper size:** A5, 210 mm x 148 mm
- No page numbering
- Hyphenation is allowed
- [Equations should be inserted using Microsoft Equation Editor](#)
- **Diagrams and images** must be submitted as embedded images in your document and as separate files as well which should be provided in standard formats such as tiff, jpg, bmp. The image resolution must be at least 96 dpi. Diagrams and images must be print-ready and submitted in black and white.
- The document should be saved in Microsoft Office Word 2003/2007 format
